

BASIC PAINTING – SUPPLY LIST

- 1. Colors for Painting** – You may use oil paints or acrylics – these are the basic colors. The ones in red are important. **Beginners need white and one other color for the first class.**

Cobalt blue

Ultramarine blue

Alizarin crimson

Cadmium red light – Cadmium red light Hue is ok

Cadmium yellow light – Cadmium yellow Lt Hue is ok

Lemon yellow or Hansa yellow

Yellow ochre

Viridian green

Sap green

Manganese purple

Raw umber

Titanium White - Large tube

Ivory Black - transparent

Palette for your colors (a butcher tray or a large paper palette)

One Palette Knife for mixing colors

- 2. Brushes** - Bristle brushes – there are hundreds of brushes to choose from...these are basic for class

Flats (one each): #4, #6,

Brights (one each): #6, #10

Rounds (one each): #4, #6

- 3. Quart of Turpenoid or Gamsol if using oil paints/ Acrylic medium if using acrylics & a small water sprayer**
- 4. Painting Surfaces** – you will have the option of more painting surfaces and sizes – a demonstration of preparing paper for painting and of preparing a canvas from scratch will be given the first class

Two canvas boards or stretched canvases approx. 18" x 24" – **no smaller**

General -

Bring all your paints and brushes to class each week

You will need a couple of jars and if using oils, metal coffee can

Rags, roll of paper towels

Plastic wrap (something like saran wrap) optional
